Michael S. Steele, Chairman of GOPAC

A self-described Lincoln Republican, Michael S. Steele earned a place in history in 2003 when he became the first African-American elected to statewide office in Maryland. Steele's engaging speaking style and his experiences as a successful elected Republican African-American in one of the country's most Democrat states have launched him into national prominence.

His first major national exposure was during an appearance at the 2004 Republican National Convention. During the difficult 2006 election, Steele defied odds by coming within mere points of winning a seat in the U.S. Senate from his heavily Democrat home state of Maryland.

Michael Steele now serves as Chairman of GOPAC, a grassroots organization founded by Former Speaker Newt Gingrich to help Republicans win control of the U.S. House of Representatives in 1994.

In this role, Steele appears frequently as a guest on political talk shows such as Fox News Channel's *Hannity and Colmes*, HBO's *Real Time with Bill Maher* and Comedy Central's *The Colbert Report*.

Lt. Governor Steele serves on the Administrative Board of the Maryland Catholic Conference and is a member of St. Mary's Catholic Church in Landover Hills, MD, where he attends mass regularly with his wife Andrea and their two sons Michael and Drew.
